5. Submit application and supporting documentation to altrusafot@juno.com no later than mid-night on April 1, 2021. Application packets received via mail, fax or after the due date will not be accepted.
6. Scholarship funds are to be used for enrollment, textbooks and/or supplies.

The following required items MUST be combined and returned as one PDF document:

1. Completed application with essay not to exceed 500 words.
2. One letter of recommendation
3. List of community service or volunteer activities including hours, if applicable
4. Copy of most recent transcripts
